Players/teams:

The tournament is limited to a maximum of 10 teams in the B, C and D categories. This may be increased! The E Junior tournament takes place on just one day (Saturday). These teams may also stay for two nights. A maximum of 20 players is permitted per B, C and D team. If your squad is larger, please request additional information on registration!



Tournament fee / registration:

The registration fee is 30 € per team and is payable after receipt of acceptance and no later than 1.5.2015. We charge 15 € per participant for accommodation, breakfast and one warm meal on Saturday. Accommodation:

Camping is permitted in the grounds of the Sports Club. We can also provide tents if so required. If you would like to camp, please let us know this on your registration form and state the number of persons who need tents (tent size approx. 26m²)! A strict no-alcohol policy applies to all players throughout the entire duration of the tournament, both on the grounds of the sports club and the camping area.

Tournament regulations:

The B junior teams play on a grass pitch for 11 players, the C junior teams play on a grass pitch for 9 players and the D junior players on grass pitch for 7 players, each with off-side markings. The E junior teams play on a grass pitch for 7 players without off-side markings. The players in the B teams must be U17, the C teams must be U15 or younger, in the D teams must be U13 or younger, the E Teams must be U11 and younger. The B, C and D junior teams will firstly be split into 2 groups with 5 teams in each group of the qualification rounds, followed by semi-final and finals. The E junior teams play in one group. The tournament plan will be sent out to participants after the closing date for registration or once the tournament is fully booked. This plan is subject to alteration depending on the level of registrations.

Prizes:

All participating teams receive a prize. In addition, we are awarding prizes for the best striker, best goalkeeper and the best team for “fair play”. The presentation ceremony takes place directly after the final.

ATS Buntentor Sports Club:

The ATS Buntentor is a traditional Sports Club with a strong sense of community and social interaction. When we say “traditional”, we don’t mean old fashioned. In addition to the 'classic' sports such as football, handball, gymnastics and tennis, our sports club is a pioneer in the field of new trend sport groups such as unihockey and lacrosse, both very quick sports that are becoming increasingly popular. Our sports club is also noteworthy for the large amount of women and girls football offered. Our first ladies team have been Bremen champions and cup winners on several occasions.
